That expense then must be brought to the board at the next board meeting. Chairman Tjarks called for a roll call vote: Nath: no, Waechter: yes, Stecker: yes, Tjarks: no. Motion failed.

Motion by Waechter and 2nd by Nath to have Derek move the owl recording devices in the board room to the board desk. Motion carried 3-1 with Tjarks being the no vote.

Motion by Stecker to have GPS on all county owned vehicles except law enforcement and set up an account for viewing by each supervisor. Stecker withdrew the motion. The board will do more research on the subject.

The board discussed the review of the Kossuth County Handbook. The handbook committee will continue updating the handbook.

Motion by Nath and 2nd by Waechter to approve the request of the Iowa Department of Transportation to use County Roads 210th Street and 20th Avenue (P16) as a detour route while repair work is being completed on railroad intersection 385628G near Whittemore, Iowa. The route will begin at the junction of IA 15 and 210th Street, thence east on 210th Street approximately one mile to the junction of County Road 20th Avenue (P16), thence north approximately 1.25 miles to the junction of IA 18. Motion carried unanimously.

There was no construction in the right of way.

Discussion was held with the Kosuth County Engineer/Zoning Administrator.

Motion by Stecker and 2nd by Nath to set February 16, 2023 at 1:30 p.m. at the Eagle Center in Lakota as the date and time for a Drain 129 informational landowner meeting. Bolton & Menk will take the minutes of the meeting to be placed in the drainage record. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Stecker and 2nd by Waechter to approve Change Order 1 for DD 4 Lat 11 OD repairs in the amount of \$4,562 for additional tile outlet pipes and CMP. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Stecker and 2nd by Nath to approve Pay App 2 sub-final for DD 4 Lat 11 OD repairs in the amount of \$81,092.57 payable to Reutzel Excavating. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Stecker and 2nd by Nath to approve Change Order 1 for DD 60 Sub 1 Tile Improvement in the amount of \$21,047.92 for additional stabilization rock and additional Tee. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Stecker and 2nd by Nath to approve Pay App 3 for DD 60 Sub 1 Tile Improvement in the amount of \$47,509.06 payable to Zachary Laubenthal Excavating. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Waechter and 2nd by Stecker to have the board members handle their requests as follows: Supervisor Tjarks: Request #2023-001 Drain TRI 84. Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion was held with the Kossuth County Auditor and the Kossuth County Board of Supervisors.
