RESOLUTION 07-11-23-02

WHEREAS, it is desired to authorize the Auditor to periodically transfer sums from the General Basic and Rural Services Basic Funds to the Secondary Road Fund during the 23-24 Fiscal Budget Year, and

WHEREAS, said transfers must be in accordance with section 331.429, Code of Iowa, as follows:

- Section 1: The total maximum transfer from the General Basic fund to the Secondary Road Fund For Fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, shall not exceed the sum \$284,511 and the total Maximum transfer from the Rural Services Basic Fund to the Secondary Road Fund for The Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2023, shall not exceed the sum of \$2,038,384.
- Section 2: Within 3-10 days of being notified of the apportionment of current property taxes, state Replacements against levied property taxed, mobile home taxes, military service tax Credit replacements, or to the General Basic or Rural Services Basic Funds, the Auditor Shall order a transfer from said fund to the Secondary Road.
- Section 3: The amount of the transfer required by Section 2 shall be equal to the apportionment Made under Section 2 to the General Basic or Rural Services Basic fund, respectively, Multiplied by the ratio of said funds total maximum transfer to the Secondary Road Fund, to the sum of said funds total current property tax levy, total mobile home taxes, Total military service tax credit replacements, and total livestock credit replacements.
- Section 4:Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 2 and 3 of this resolution to the Secondary
Road Fund shall not exceed the amounts specified in Section 1.
- Section 5: Notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 2 and 3 of this resolution, the amount of any Transfer shall not exceed available fund balances in the transferring fund.
- Section 6: The Auditor is directed to correct her books when said operating transfers are made and To notify the County Treasurer and County Engineer of the amounts of said transfers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Kossuth County Board of Supervisors declare this resolution adopted July 11, 2023.

Motion by Stecker and 2nd by Waechter to acknowledge the FY 23-24 Prorated Funding for Ag Land at 21.71514547% and Prorated Funding for Family Farms at 15.46026369%. Chairman Tjarks called for a roll call vote: Plathe: yes, Nath: yes, Waechter: yes, Stecker: yes, Tjarks: yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Stecker and 2nd by Waechter to approve adding the presented Work Period and Overtime – Jailers/Sheriff to Section 2.2 in the Kossuth County Handbook. Motion carried unanimously.

RESOLUTION TO MODIFY Kossuth County Secondary Road FY2024 Construction Program Kossuth County Resolution #_____

WHEREAS, Kossuth County approved Fiscal Year 2024 Secondary Roads Five Year Program (CFYP) on April 11, 2023, and

WHEREAS, Iowa Department of Transportation approved the CFYP on May 8, 2023, and

WHEREAS, the CFYP contains projects that are funded with but not limited to Local, Farm to Market, Special, Federal Aid and Swap funds, and

WHEREAS, Projects that are funded with Federal Aid and Swap funds are included in Iowa's Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), and

WHEREAS, Projects that are funded with Federal Aid and Swap funds are required to have programed costs that are at minimum 85% of the Engineer's Estimate, and

WHEREAS, The current Engineer's Estimate for BROS-C055(199)--5F-55, TPMS #24976, and BRS-C055(200)--60-50, TPMS #45178, is significantly higher than the funded amount contained in Kossuth County's 2024 Fiscal Year Construction Program, and

WHEREAS, Kossuth County desires to increase the programed fund amounts of the previously mentioned projects to reflect the Engineer's Estimate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Kossuth County Board of Supervisors to approve CFYP Revision 1 which increases the funded amount of project BROS-C055(199)--5F-55, TPMS 324976 from \$440,000 Federal Aid and \$110,000 SWAP funds to \$540,000 Federal Aid and \$135,000 SWAP and of Project BRS-C055(200)--60-50, TPMS #45178 from \$550,000 Federal Aid to \$725,000 Federal Aid.
